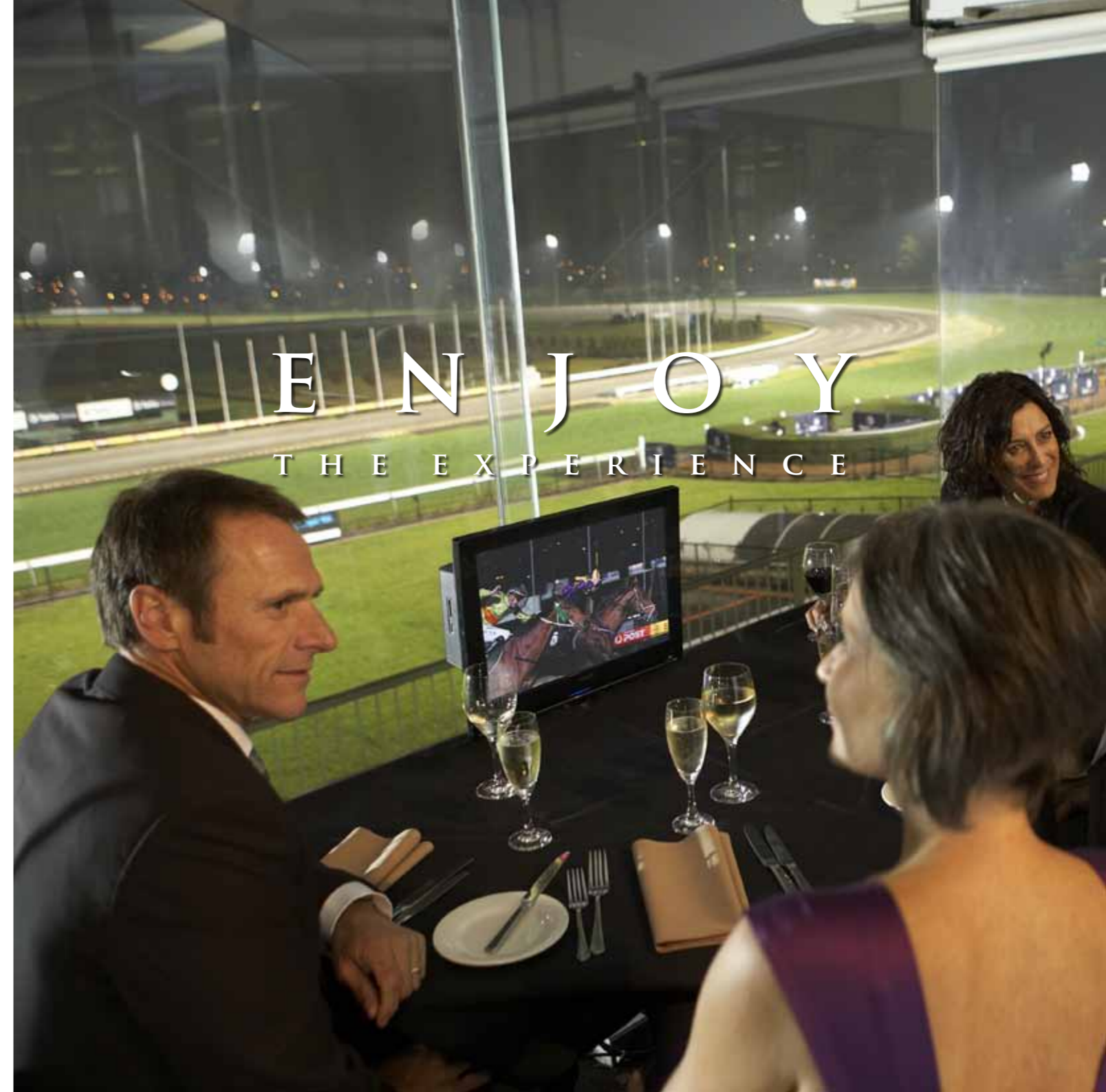

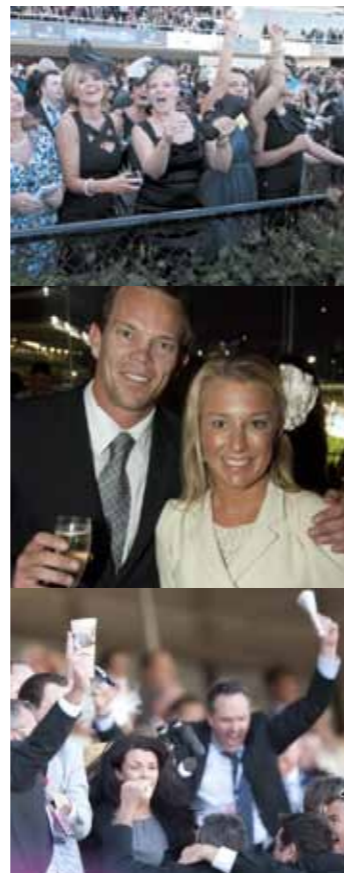

MVRC Members are welcome to attend races and utilise Members' facilities at select Australian and International racing clubs upon payment of the daily racecourse admission price.

METROPOLITAN RACING CLUBS

Reciprocal rights entitle MVRC Full Members to the Members' enclosures at the Victoria Racing Club and Melbourne Racing Club, (Flemington, Caulfield, Mornington and Sandown) during selected midweek and non-feature Saturday and Sunday race meetings throughout the season. Please note this excludes public holidays, Spring Racing Carnival and Thousand Guineas Day.

Members are required to pay course admission before presenting their Membership Card at the hosting club's Race Day Office. Members' guests will be afforded the same privileges when accompanied by the Member (one guest per Member).

VICTORIAN PROVINCIAL CLUBS

MVRC Members are welcome to attend races at Victorian provincial racing clubs. Members will receive a Members' pass on production of their current Membership Card at the Secretary's Office. Members are required to pay the daily racecourse admission.

Please note: This excludes all Country Cup meetings and the Warrnambool Cup Carnival.

INTERSTATE CLUBS

MVRC has reciprocal arrangements at metropolitan racing clubs Australia wide. To view a list of reciprocal clubs, please visit www.mvrc.net.au.

Please note that some charges may apply for reciprocity and Full Members should confirm prices with the particular race club they wish to attend.

INTERNATIONAL RACING CLUBS

MVRC Members are generally welcome at racing clubs around the world. Any Member wishing to attend an international racing club should contact the Membership Department to request a 'Letter of Introduction' from MVRC. Requests must be made in writing at least five working days prior to departure.

Arrangements between MVRC and overseas clubs are a goodwill gesture and it is at the discretion of the individual clubs whether they extend reciprocal privileges.

MEMBERS' RESERVED CAR PARKING

MVRC is pleased to offer its Members complimentary onsite car parking during Moonee Valley race meetings and events.

The Car Park Pass admits to the Members' Reserved Car Park on McPherson Street and the Centre Car Park.

The pass is issued to all Members upon payment of their annual fee, and must be affixed to the inside windscreen prior to the vehicle entering the Members' Reserved Car Park and while the car remains in the Car Park.

CENTRE CAR PARK

The Centre Car Park is located at the centre of the race track. Entry is from Dean Street or Wilson Street near the freeway via gates 6 or 7. The Centre Car Park is only reserved for Members until the first race.

MEMBERS' DISABLED CAR PARK

Moonee Valley Racing Club has limited onsite space for cars driven by Members with disabilities. The Club has set aside an area in the McPherson Street Members' Reserved Car park and the Centre Car Park.

Space is extremely limited and although all measures will be taken to ensure Members with disabilities are accommodated, this cannot be guaranteed.

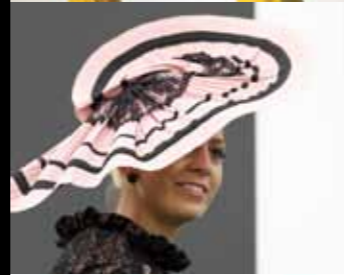

MEMBERS' CAR PARKING MCPHERSON STREET CAR PARK

On Tatts Cox Plate Day, only those Members displaying the pre-purchased Tatts Cox Plate Day Car Park Pass will be permitted to park in the McPherson Street Car Park. Access to the McPherson Street Car Park will be via Thomas Street (McPherson Street is closed on Tatts Cox Plate Day).

CENTRE CAR PARK

This car park reaches capacity very early on Tatts Cox Plate Day and Members are advised to arrive early to secure parking.

The Centre Car Park is the only Car Park Members will be admitted to with their Members' Car Park Pass.

DISABLED CAR PARK PASSES

To book and purchase a disabled car park space on Tatts Cox Plate Day, please contact the Membership Office prior to the day.

APPRENTICE MEMBERSHIP

MVRC are excited to announce the initiation of a new Apprentice Membership category for those aged 13 to 17 years. This Membership package is the perfect stepping stone for your children/grandchildren towards Full Membership upon reaching 18 years of age. The Apprentice Membership program will be priced at \$29 per Member and includes:

- Elevation to MVRC Full Membership upon reaching 18 years of age
- Membership Card
- Admission to the racecourse for all MVRC racemeetings
- Admission to the Members' Reserve for all MVRC racemeetings
- Admission to the Apprentice Member enclosure on selected racedays

All Apprentice Members will need to be accompanied by an adult when attending Moonee Valley Racecourse. Underage gambling is illegal and will not be condoned or offered at events staged for Apprentice Members.

JUNIOR JOCKS CLUB

Members' children are invited to join the Junior Jocks Club. Junior Jocks Club Membership for the 2011/12 season will be complimentary. Designed for children aged 12 and under, the Membership includes invitations to events and activities days throughout the year such as the twilight Christmas racemeeting (Sunday 11 December) with show rides, jumping castles, roving entertainment and more.

ABSENTEE MEMBERSHIP

If you have been a MVRC Member previously and are aware that you will be unable to attend race meetings throughout the 2011/12 season, you may wish to keep your Membership current by becoming an Absentee Member.

Absentee Membership is \$50 per person, per year, and ensures you receive communication from the Club.

Please note that an Absentee Membership does not include annual ticketing, access to the Race for Awards program or eligibility to vote.

DAILY AND ANNUAL GUEST PASSES

MEMBERS' GUEST

Members are welcome to purchase up to 6 Members' Reserve Daily Guest Passes per race meeting (excluding Tatts Cox Plate Day) and can also purchase one fully transferable Members' Annual Guest Pass.

A Members' Annual Guest Pass grants access to the racecourse and Members' Reserve including bars and dining rooms at all Moonee Valley race meetings including Tatts Cox Plate Day.

An Annual Members' Guest Pass for 2011/12 season is \$220

MVRC strongly encourages the pre-purchase of Members' Reserve Daily Guest Passes and Annual Guest Passes prior to all race meetings including Tatts Cox Plate Day by contacting Customer Service on 1300 79 79 59. For further information on Tatts Cox Plate Day guest tickets, please see page 12 of this handbook.

JUNIOR TICKETS

Members with children under the age of 18 may apply for a daily Members' Junior ticket to enable them to use facilities within the Members' Reserve. Tickets may be obtained free of charge (excluding Tatts Cox Plate Day) from the Race Day Office on race days. Children are required to have a Junior Pass displayed on them at all times whilst in the Members' Reserve.

Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult Member and are permitted into most Members' Reserve areas, with exceptions to the Members' Parade Bar and Silks (except when this room is used as an extension of the Members' Dining Room), which are exclusively for adult Members.

Children are not permitted in the mounting yard (except viewing areas) and in the horse walk leading to the weigh-in area.

Members are reminded that they are responsible for the behaviour and dress standard of their guests and children at all times.

The Membership Office is located on the ground floor of the MVRC Administration Building inside Gate 1 off McPherson Street, Moonee Ponds.

LOST MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND CAR PASSES

The loss or theft of Membership Cards or Members' Car Park Passes must be reported verbally or in writing to the MVRC Membership Department as soon as possible to prevent any unauthorised use.

A replacement card or Car Park Pass will be issued by mail after submission of a completed card replacement form or a statutory declaration explaining the loss.

There is a replacement fee of \$20 per missing card (including GST). Payment of this fee must accompany the completed form or statutory declaration. This fee will be waived if a police report accompanies the statutory declaration.

FAULTY CARDS

Should you encounter problems when scanning your Membership Card at the turnstiles, please report it to the Race Day Office or Information Booth on raceday.

MISUSE OF MEMBERS' CARDS

The Moonee Valley Racing Club Membership card is issued for personal use only and cannot be used by any other person.

Lending a Membership card for the admission of a non Member to the racecourse or Members' Reserve is a serious breach of Club Rules. It is also a breach of the rules if a Member does

not take sufficient care to ensure the Membership Card is not misused. Lending of Membership Cards to purchase daily Members' guest tickets is also prohibited. MVRC officials have the authority under Club rules and regulations to request proof of identity at any time.

Please note that MVRC Membership cards remain the property of MVRC.

MEMBERSHIP PAYMENT OPTIONS

MVRC's preferred method of payment for renewals and bookings is via credit card. Cheques mailed to MVRC and cash payments made at MVRC Office (McPherson St, Moonee Ponds) will also be taken.

MVRC also offers a direct debit payment whereby Members can elect to have their Membership fees deducted from a nominated bank account or credit card. A copy of the Direct Debit Request form is included in your Membership Renewal pack.

If you have misplaced your form, please contact the Membership Department on 1300 79 79 59 and a replacement form will be issued. Should you have any queries regarding direct debit payments, please contact Debit Success on 1800 148 848.

GATE OPENING TIMES

Standard Saturday and midweek race meetings – Approximately 90 minutes before the first race.

Night Meeting – Approximately 5.15pm (90 minutes before the first race).

Tatts Cox Plate Day – Gates open at 10am

ON COURSE FACILITIES

ATM / EFTPOS CASH WITHDRAWALS

Automatic teller machines are located in the Celebrity Foyer and the south end of the Paddock Tote.

CLOAKROOM

The cloakroom is located on the first floor near JR's Wine Lounge. The cloakroom closes 30 minutes after the last race at all race meetings.

Lost property enquiries can be made at the Race Day Office or by phoning MVRC Reception on 9373 2222 after the racemeeting.

FIRST AID ROOM

St John Ambulance personnel are present on course for the duration of a race meeting.

The first aid room is located behind the Race Day Office.

OWNERS

Members who have a horse entered at a race meeting are required to report to the Race Day Office where additional ticketing will be arranged.

TRANSPORT TO AND FROM THE RACECOURSE

TAXIS

Available after the races on McPherson Street.
There is also a taxi rank on Mt Alexander Road,
(off McPherson Street, towards Pascoe Vale Road).

TRAIN

Craigieburn line from Flinders Street Station stops at
Moonee Ponds Station. MVRC is a 10 minute walk
down Puckle Street.

TRAM AND BUS

Terminals are located at the Moonee Ponds
Junction (off Puckle Street and Pascoe Vale Road,
Mt Alexander and Ascot Vale Roads). Tram no.
59 from Elizabeth Street in the city arrives at the
Junction terminal. From there it is a 200m walk to the
turnstile entrance on McPherson Street.



MEMBERS' DRESS REGULATIONS

DAY MEETINGS (INCLUDING TATTS COX PLATE DAY)

Gentlemen (including children 15 & over)
are required to wear a collar and tie,
tailored trousers and either a suit coat,
sports coat or blazer.

Ladies are expected to maintain a suitable
standard of dress in keeping with the
distinction of the Members' Reserve.

NIGHT MEETINGS

Gentlemen (including children 15 & over)
are required to wear a collared business
shirt (polo shirts not permitted) with
tailored trousers. No tie required, and suit
coat, sports coat or blazer is optional.

Ladies are expected to maintain a suitable
standard of dress in keeping with the
distinction of the Members' Reserve.



ATTIRE NOT ALLOWED IN MEMBERS' RESERVE

The following items of clothing or similar are not
permitted in the Members' Reserve at any time:

Gentlemen – Any variation of runner (including
joggers), sandals, thongs or any dilapidated
footwear. Denim and denim-look clothing, jeans,
jodhpurs, shorts, shirts without a collar, polo shirts,
parkas, windbreakers, tracksuits, jackets including
bomber jackets, duffle coats, leather jackets,
peaked caps, beanies, pullovers or cardigans
without a jacket, sporting guernseys.

Ladies - Any variation of runner (including
joggers), thongs or any dilapidated footwear.
Denim and denim-look clothing, jeans, jodhpurs,
shorts, polo shirts, parkas, windbreakers,
tracksuits, jackets including bomber jackets,
duffle coats, untailored leather jackets, peaked
caps, beanies, sporting guernseys, any clothing
revealing bare midriff.

(Children under 15 are expected to maintain a
suitable standard of dress all year round).

*Note: Members and their guest/s may be refused
entry to the Members' Reserve by Club Staff if it is
felt that these standards are not being adhered to.
Club Management reserves the right to exercise
discretion in respect to dress code.*

5.3 The MVRC reserves the right to change the date of race meetings from time to time, held at MVRC.

5.4 If a race meeting is transferred to MVRC from another Club, this meeting does not constitute part of the Race for Awards program.

6. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

6.1 These Terms and Conditions govern all aspects of the Race for Awards Program.

6.2 Members accept these Terms and Conditions upon paying their subscription.

6.3 Member Metres and awards cannot be redeemed for cash or other products.

6.4 If a Member cannot accept any of the awards in the specified time period or is unavailable for any of the invitations to the events, then these awards become null and void. Furthermore, these awards will not be transferable to other MVRC Members or Non-Members of the Club.
